JOBLESS TO MARCH ON TRINITY VESTRY

Mr. Zero To Make An Effort To Have Chapel Opened To Ragged Army For Shelter During Winter.

NEW YORK, Dec. 23.—(By International News.)—A regiment of the hopeless led by "Mr. Zero" champion of the jobless is scheduled to march on the New York financial district tomorrow.

The ragged army, "Mr. Zero" said today, will stage a silent demonstration in front of the office of rich vestrymen of Trinity church.

"We hope through this demonstration," said "Mr. Zero," "to get the use of St. Augustine chapel to shelter jobless men. The congregation of St. Augustine has only fifty persons. The church would house 1,000 men who have no shelter."

While the "regiment" is standing "heel to heel" at the curb, "Mr. Zero" will go, he said, to the offices of rich vestrymen and make his plea. "For three years I have been trying to get St. Augustine's chapel," said "Mr. Zero," "but always I

have been put off. Several years ago I attended a conference of high church officials and we talked about the chapel, but nothing came of it. I was told then that it was a matter for the vestrymen to decide. The proposition was to have been laid before the vestrymen. That's the last I ever heard of it.

The regiment of 500 strong was being organized today at the T. R. five-cent eating house which "Mr. Zero" maintains.

The men are to march according to "Mr. Zero's" plan, two by two down Broadway to Wall street, thence into Broad street. There are to be two main orders. One will be "halt!" The other "heel to the curb!" Any man who disobeys orders or becomes other than a silent demonstrator will be taken in hand by one of the ex-service men, there being an ex-service man to every twenty men. Those of the jobless who have hats will remove them in front of the vestrymen's offices.

"Mr. Zero" said he would say to the vestrymen: "Can you eat or sleep in peace as caretakers of Christ's property on the sacred anniversary while your brothers are shelterless and starving?" MAIL RECORDS HERE BROKEN YESTERDAY

More Than 170,000 Letters, Cards, and 10,000 Packages Sent; Quick Service At House Doors Asked.

Mail records were shattered at the local post office yesterday when more than 170,000 letters and cards passed through the cancelling machine and more than 10,000 packages were weighed, stamped and dispatched.

It took ten men working at top speed from 7 a. m. until 9 p. m. yesterday to handle the packages alone. Of the 10,000 packages sent, more than 4,000 were insured.

Postmaster Frank Hahn said the volume of mail yesterday broke all previous records here. He accounted for the heavy mailing because folk here probably did their Christmas shopping last week then waited until Sunday to wrap and address the packages for mailing yesterday.

Parcel post carriers are finding that more than ever this year the doors of Cedar Rapids are closed to Santa Claus. The reluctance of housewives to answer the doorbell is materially slowing up the delivery of many Christmas packages, it was reported at the post office.

If the housewife does not answer the door when the carrier rings, it will be her fault if the package destined for the home is taken back to the post office. Postal regulations do not compel a carrier to go to the back door. A carrier who rings the front door bell or knocks has done his duty and is justified in taking the package back to the office.

Parcel post men and carriers will make one delivery Christmas morning, and will be excused from duty at 11 a. m. to enjoy the holiday. There will be no rural deliveries Christmas day and the post office will be closed, but mails will be dispatched on the usual holiday schedule.

Bulgarian Murders Macedonian Chief In Red Discussion

ROME, Dec. 23.—(By International News.)—The Bulgarian nationalist Dimitri Stophanoff killed Prof. Peter Teuhaleff, a Bolshevik and Macedonian chief, in a small coffee house in Milan today.

Stophanoff accused Teuhaleff of having paid Moscow Bolsheviks to ruin the Balkan nation. Teuhaleff denied this. Angry words followed and Stophanoff drew a pistol and fired five shots into Teuhaleff's body.

JONES COUNTY BANK CASES ARE SETTLED

MONTICELLO, Dec. 23.—Suits brought by Jones county banks in protest against tax assessments were settled in district court this week with Judge Ellison presiding. It was decided that the banks should pay \$3.75 per cent of the taxes assessed against them on an 80 per cent basis for the years 1922, 1923 and 1924. This decree will bring into the county treasury about \$31,000 this month. Some of the banks had paid one-half of the taxes for the last two years.
