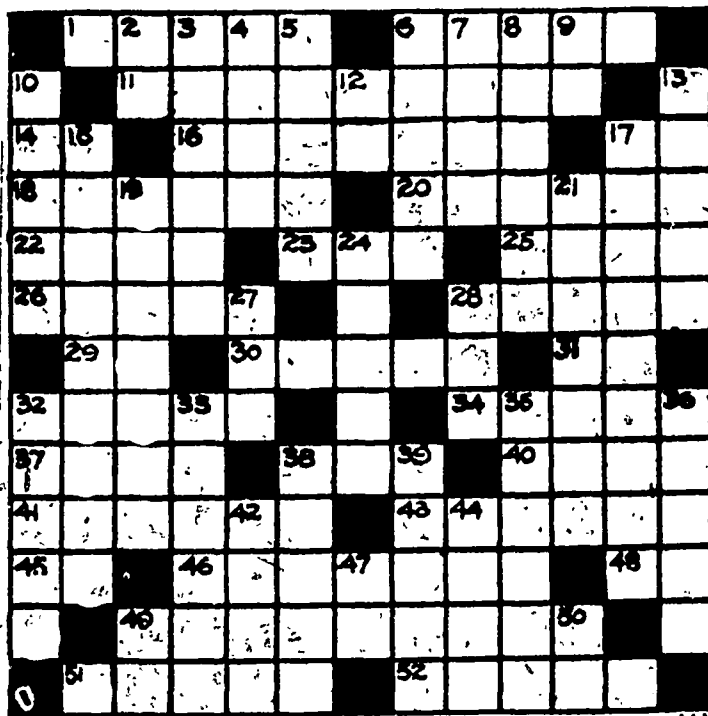
Michigan Girl, 19, Gets 1 To 7 Years For Aiding Slayer

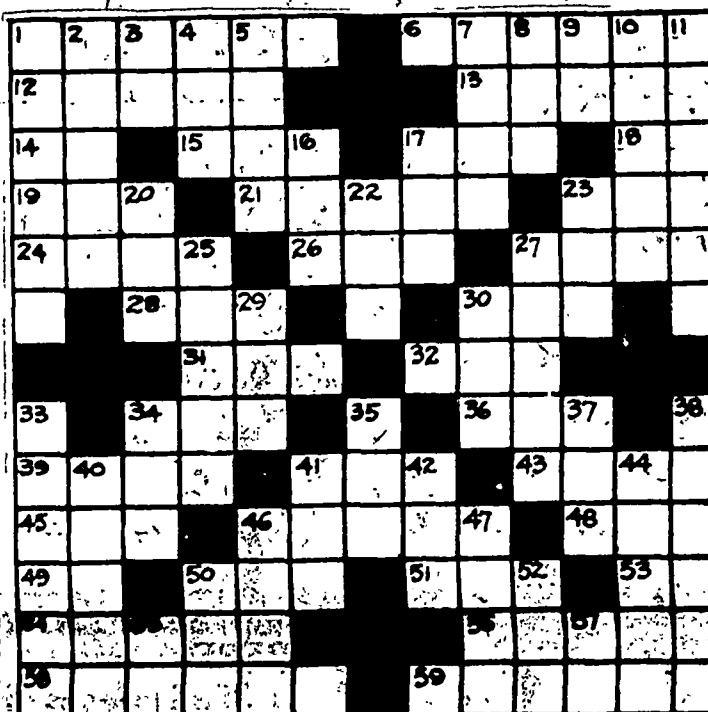
OUR CROSS-WORD PUZZLE

UNCLE WIGGILY AND JILLIE'S TRAP

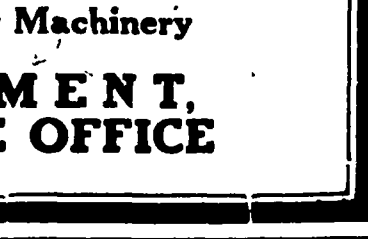
