

LETTERS SENT TODAY ON COLISEUM MEET

Letters are going out today from the city of Cedar Rapids to the American Legion, the city council, the zoning commission and practically all civic and patriotic organizations of the city asking them to send representatives to a meeting to be held Wednesday at 7:30 p. m. in the superior court room of the city hall for the purpose of discussing the memorial coliseum project.

It was decided to hold this meeting after a conference Wednesday night of members of the board of education, the American Legion and the coliseum committee of the Chamber of Commerce. The school board has offered to delay its program for building two new senior high schools if the coliseum project is to be put before the voters this year.

The American Legion has been on record for years in favor of a memorial coliseum building and now the definite attitude of other organizations is asked. The state law prohibits a bond issue for such a structure and it is probable that the question will be put before the people soon.

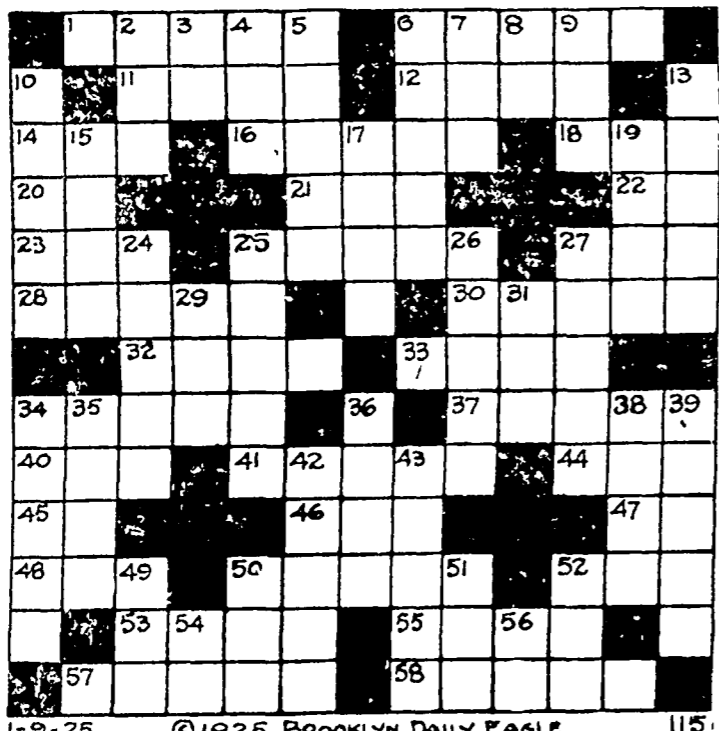

Illinois Bus Hits Auto In Fog, Two Killed, Three Hurt

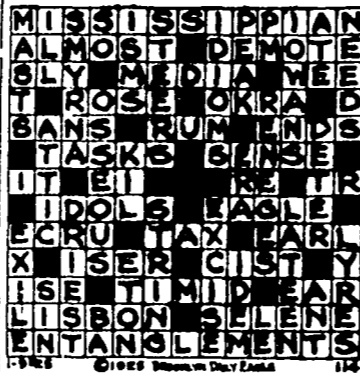
GALESBURG, Ill., Jan. 9.—(By Associated Press.)—Two Monmouth men were killed and three injured when their automobile hit the Galesburg Monmouth bus today. Everett Kissick 20 and Harold McKnight were killed. The injured are Lenny Murphy, Lawrence and Edward Kissick, the latter the father of Everett. They are in a hospital here.

Passengers in the bus said the automobile suddenly loomed ahead in the dense fog and the driver attempted to turn out but skidded and crashed head on into the machine. Everett Kissick, driving the touring car was hurled through the windshield of the car onto the bus windshield. W. B. McCullough, driver of the bus, suffered a broken arm and his hand was badly cut by broken glass when Kissick's body struck his machine, but none of the twelve passengers was seriously injured. Among the passengers in the bus were E. J. Plithony, Chicago; K. W. Donnell of Peoria and W. C. McGuire also of Peoria.
