ANN ARBOR, Jan. 12.—More than 80 men, many of them sophomores, have reported to Coach Steve Farrell to try for places on the Michigan track squad and this number will be increased to 100 or more, it is thought, when examinations are over.

The second year men are the strongest class aggregation ever to report forVarsity track. First among this row of stars is Lechin-sky, of Detroit, who created a sensation last year when he smashed Pad docks Olympic record in the 100-yard sprint.

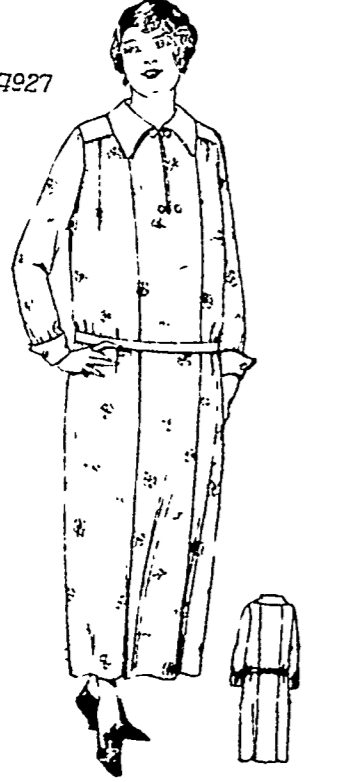
