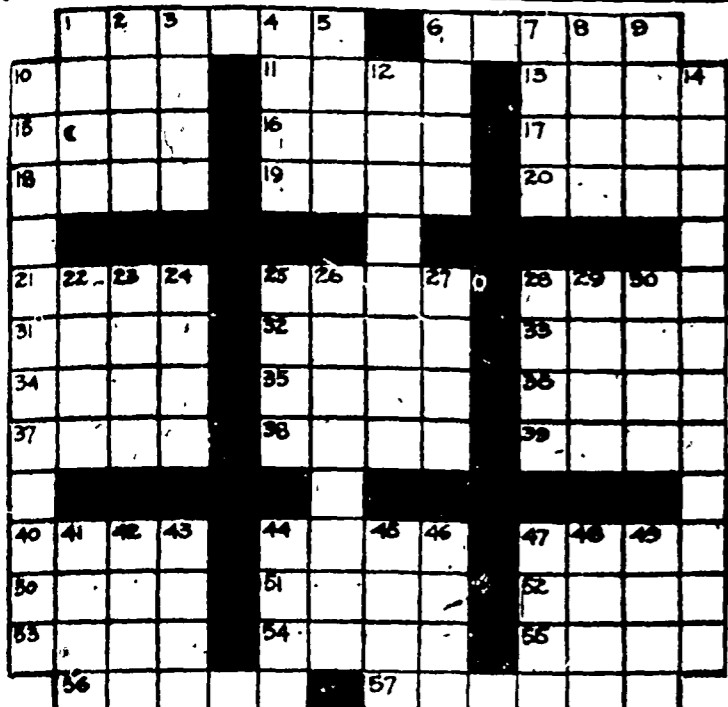


OUR CROSS-WORD PUZZLE

JURY LETS IOWA CITY MAN KEEP LIQUOR STOCK

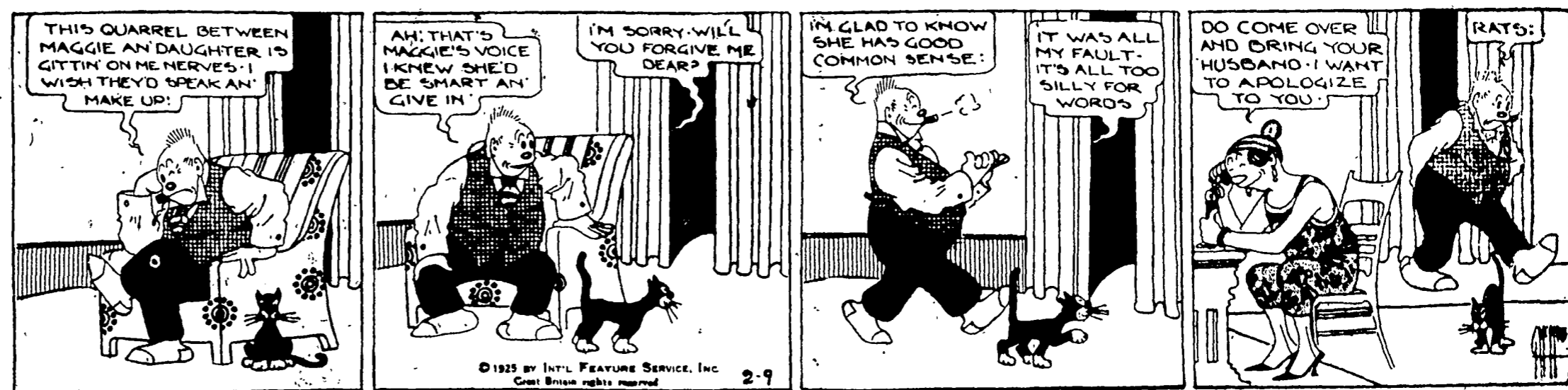

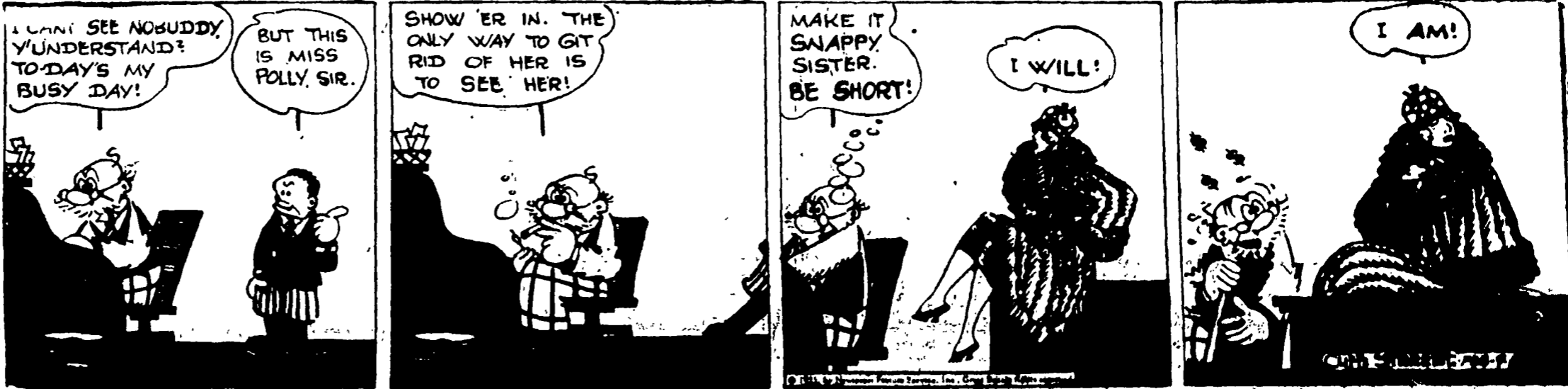

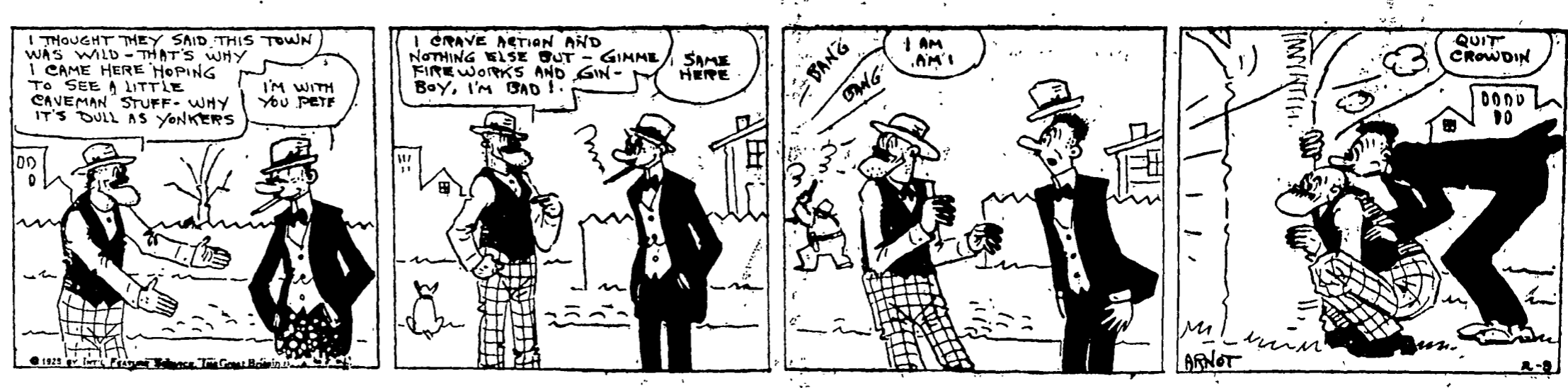
