Institution To Be Benefited By Chest Fund Provides For Feeble Folk Who Have No One To Care For Them.

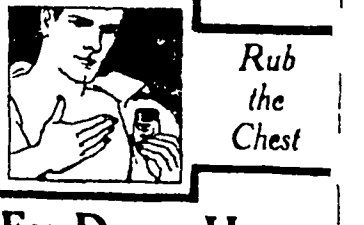
Editor's note: This is the eighth and last of a series of human interest stories about the eight local institutions represented in the Community Chest campaign.

SHELLSBURG WINS HONORS AT DECLAMATORY CONTEST

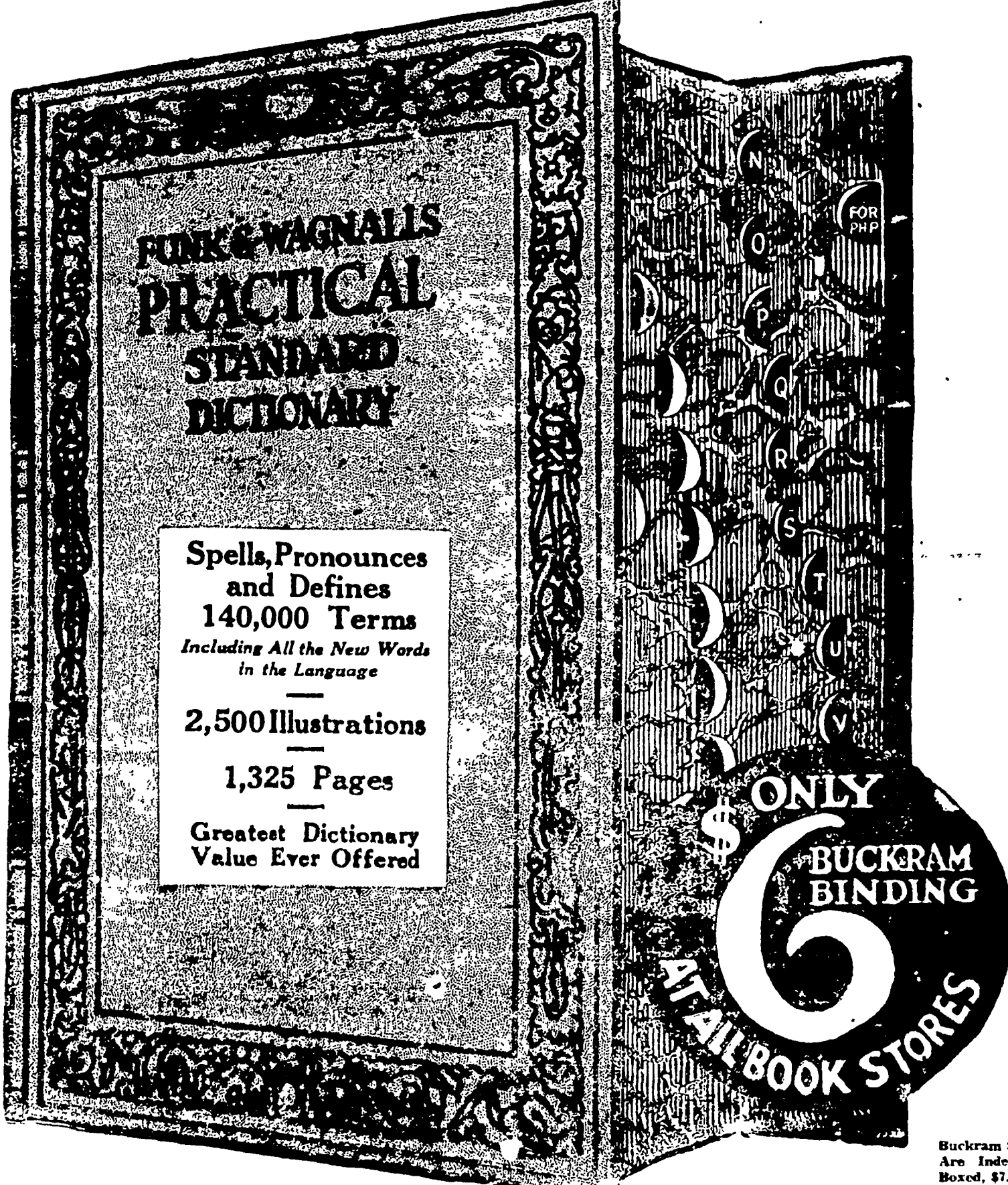
