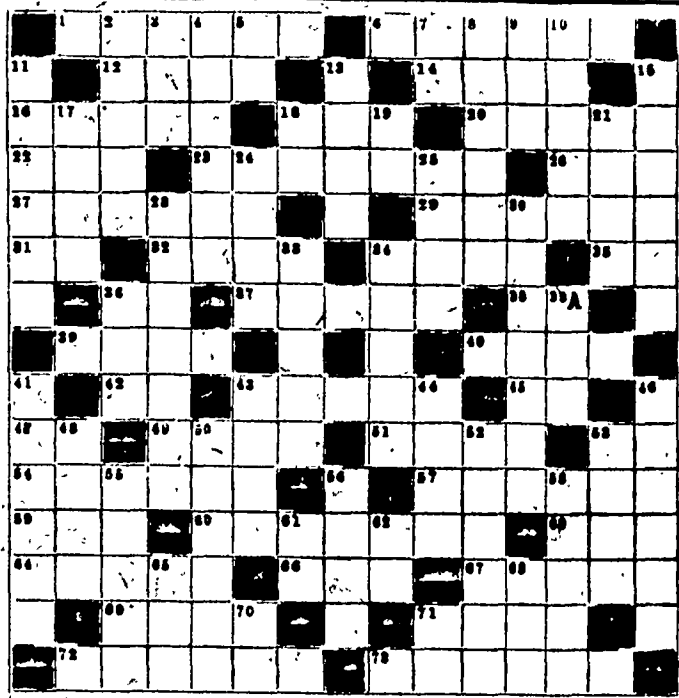

SHELLSBURG PHONE CO. ELECTS NEW OPERATORS

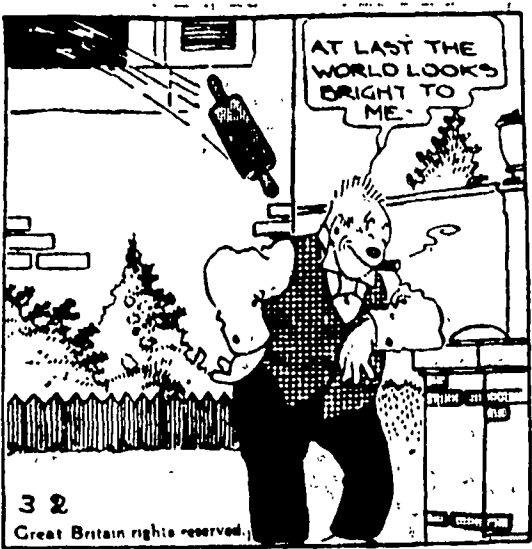
