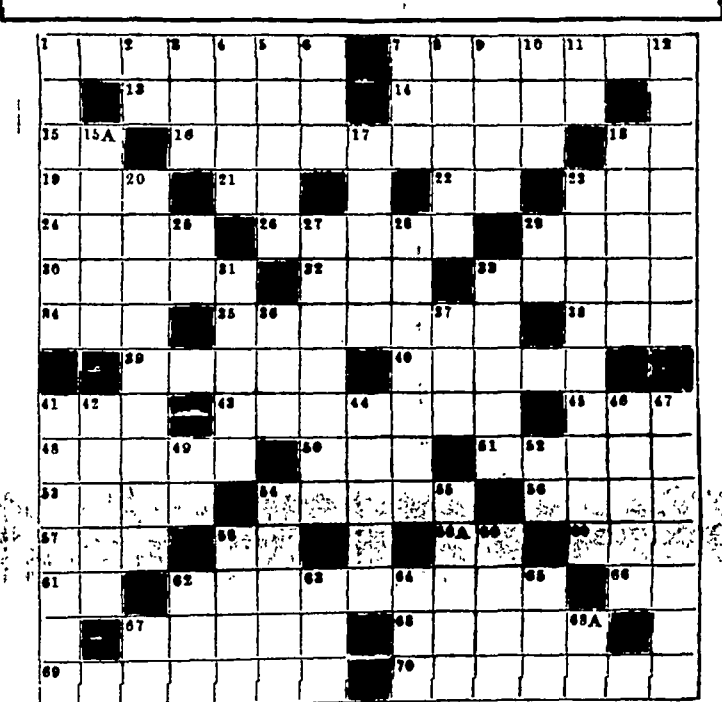
We shall now go to the passport office and struggle with the blanks that ask impertinent questions. We give our age. . . .

## OUR CROSS-WORD PUZZLE

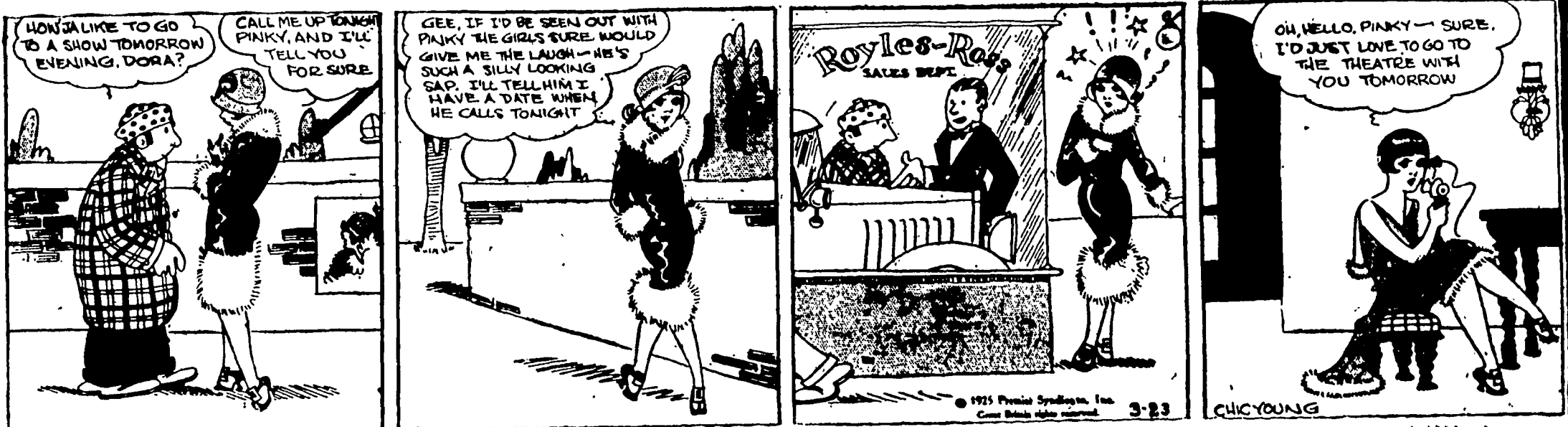
