"The Federal Reserve system has made all types of currency, except national bank notes, elastic because all except those notes can be issued in amounts required and they all tend to flow back to the Reserve hank when they are not required. There is another phase of currency elasticity. A \$100 Federal Reserve note may represent only \$40 in gold, because a gold reserve of only 40 per cent is required against Federal Reserve notes. On the other hand, formerly known as the Bellboys' and cent is required against Federal Reserve notes. 


