proved the greatest hindrance to human progress was invited by Mr Shambaugh to "read the history of

"War is conflict to the death between classes, communities, races, and nations," Mr. Shambaugh conlinued. "It is the result largely of differences growing out of class jealousy, community isolation, race prejudice, overstimulated nationalsm and popular misunderstanding. Its methods are primitive, uncivilized, brutal "Opposed to the methods of war as

And so, for the prevention of war and the maintenance of peace, let us encourage the holding of race congresses, the establishment of leagues of nations, the setting up of international courts and even the organization of a world state." ganization of a world state."




