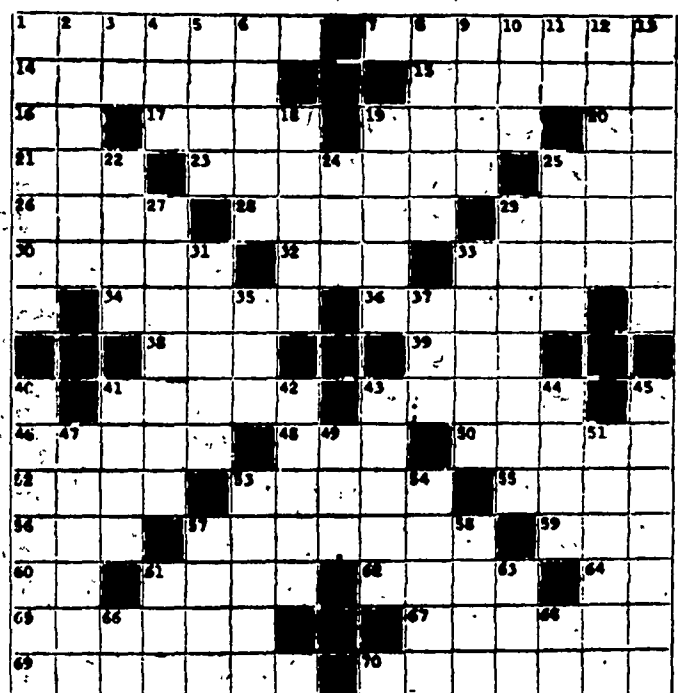

Gardens—"Adventures in My Garden and Rock Garden" by L. E. Wilder. A book that is full to overflowing of experienced advice, wise counsel, pregnant suggestion, fresh and interesting ideas, out of which anybody with a garden of any sort can get aid and inspiration.

History—"Short History of International Intercourse" by C. D. Burns. A description, by reference to certain examples, of the good influence which one nation has had on others.

Literature—"Fata Morgana" by E. Vajda. In this comedy, the author combines a deep psychological sense, a full measure of reflection and tonic irony and a nice gift of cultivated sympathy.

Manners and Customs—"Customs of Mankind" by L. Elchler. A study of the origin and evolution of man, from the dawn of life through barbarism, civilization, mediaevalism, and modernism. It contains the origins of all our social customs.

Philippine Islands—"United States and the Philippines" by D. R. Williams. Are the Philippines now capable of the self-government they seek? The author has had twenty years of observation in the Philippines. He was secretary of the Philippine commission.

Travel—"Uganda to the Cape" by F. G. Carpenter. Familiar talks about countries and peoples, with the author on the spot and the reader in his home, based on a half million miles of travel over the globe.

Fiction—"Keys of the City" by E. H. Davis. A light comedy story. The author combines a shrewd perception of people with a gift for contriving highly amusing situations.

"Day of Atonement" by L. Golding. In this story of the Jew, the author shows a profound understanding and insight.

"Behind the Ranges" by A. S. Monroe. Western story.

"Wolf" by A. P. Terhune. Another dog story, by a popular writer.

"Helen" by E. L. White. No legend of antiquity has had a greater power over the imaginations of men and women of all times than that of Helen of Troy. Mr. White has told the story here with a freshness that is entrancing.
